# Policy H17: Carousel Park, Micheldever

# **Overview of Comments:**

BHLF-KSAR-N87J-R Micheldever Parish Council	Support the policy, however would make the following points -  • a site for Travelling Showpeople should only be occupied by those who are active showpeople;  • occupancy cannot be allowed to increase beyond the capabilities / facilities of the site.  • there is a long history of no effective enforcement of this site. Lessons require to be learnt from the recent history of this site and the legal challenges that have arisen. The site and surroundings have reached an unacceptable state that cannot continue to be a drain on local population, services and utilities and a challenge for the community	The enforcement of planning consents of unauthorised development is beyond the scope of the Local Plan, but the Plan does include a policy relating to the intensification of existing sites (policy H14). Planning consent has now been granted for mixed gypsy traveller and travelling showpersons' use following an appeal against enforcement action in relation to Carousel Park.  As policy H17 seeks to retain the site for showpersons' use it is no longer relevant and should be deleted.  Recommended response: Delete policy H17:

ANON-KSAR-NK36-K	There needs to be a policy to ensure enforcement such that occupancy cannot exceed the services provided at the location (so plots cannot be subdivided).	The enforcement of planning consents or unauthorised development is beyond the scope of the Local Plan, but the Plan does include a policy relating to the intensification of existing sites (policy H14).  Recommended response: No change
ANON-KSAR-N81V-X	Agree the original plan for Carousel Park was a good one but it has been abused repeatedly which has caused very significant distress to those who live close to the plot.	Policy H17 seeks to control the extent of the Carousel Park site and ensure that expansion is avoided and other policy requirements are met. The enforcement of planning consents or unauthorised

development is beyond the scope of the Local Plan. Following an appeal against enforcement action in relation to Carousel Park consent has been granted for a mixed traveller use. As a result, policy H17 and its explanatory text should be deleted.

Respondent number  ANON-KSAR-N8Q5-W	This site is adjacent to ancient woodland at Black Wood. which must be appropriately buffered. Recommend that as a precautionary principle a minimum 50 metre buffer should be maintained, including through the construction phase, unless the applicant can demonstrate how a smaller buffer would suffice. A larger buffer may be required for particularly significant engineering operations, or for afteruses that generate significant disturbance.	Officer comment  Carousel Park is an existing traveller site, although some plots are not authorised. Policy H17 required a bund and landscaping to be provided and retained around the site. This is now a requirement of the planning conditions imposed when consent was granted on appeal for mixed traveller use. Policy H12 also sets out various requirements, including avoiding harm to biodiversity interests and that proposals are consistent with other policies (which include protection of biodiversity).

### Changes Proposed to Policy H17 Carousel Park, Micheldever

#### Delete Policy H17:

Land at Carousel Park, Micheldever (as shown on the maps below) is allocated for travelling showpersons' use. The site should be occupied by people meeting the definition of travelling showpeople, and comply with the following requirements:

- Protect the biodiversity of Black Wood (an adjacent Site of Importance for Nature Conservation SINC) and reinforce the site's visual containment by providing and retaining a bund and landscaping around the whole site boundary;
- Avoid further expansion or intensification beyond the currently-defined extent of the site;
- Satisfy the requirements of Policy H12.

### Changes Proposed to Explanatory Text

#### Delete paragraph 9.97:

9.97 Carousel Park has consent for 9 large travelling showpersons' plots but most plots are not being used for travelling showpersons' purposes and have been subdivided. Given the need for travelling showpersons' plots and the difficulty in finding suitable potential sites, it is important that all the original permitted plots are made available and retained for showpersons' use. Enforcement action is being taken to reinstate the travelling showpersons' use. The disputed use and occupancy of the site makes it difficult to determine how many additional showpersons' plots would be made available on completion of the enforcement process, but it is estimated there will be a gain of at least 8 showpersons' plots. Any changes that may result from the enforcement process, including potential intensification, should retain the use of the site for travelling showpersons, ensure an acceptable living and working environment, and meet the requirements of Policy H12.
