
1 Creating a vibrant economy (p261, para 10.9). EH suggest adding in 'heritage'. This is in the background text to the topic. The paragraph headed 'Culture, creative and visitor economy' reflects the wording in the GEDS, so I don't think we can alter this if that is not what is in the GEDS. 2 CC2 I think the convention is 'up to'. I would prefer that to 'no more than' as it doesn't seem quite so restrictive. No more than might be too absolute when we consider all aspects of the proposal eg viability.
