Thank you all for working positively to agree a way forward in relation to apportioning the Winchester Local Plan's 'unmet needs allowance' in our respective SOCGs. A key outcome of this was to agree that modifications would be put forward for consideration by the Local Plan Inspector.

On the basis of the SOCGs text, we have drafted the following proposed change to the Local Plan which we suggest should be added to a list of modifications we plan to send to PINS when we submit the Plan. We would not consult generally on these or promote them as main modifications at this stage, but we would welcome your confirmation the change set out below reflects our agreements in the SOCGs and, if not, any comments.

Regulation 19 Local Plan Table H2 (page 216). Add footnote to unmet needs allowance figure of 1,900 (**) as follows:

- "** It has been agreed that to reflect the total unmet need in the housing market area would necessitate the following;
- To Portsmouth City Council: 30% apportionment of the unmet need housing allowance in the Winchester District Local Plan;
- To Havant Borough Council: 70% apportionment of the unmet need housing allowance in the Winchester District Local Plan;
 (based upon the unmet need allowance of 1,900 homes, this would equate to 570 homes for Portsmouth City and 1,330 homes for Havant Borough)."
